I am a member of the Washington State Bar who is:

- A school director A school administrator
- Currently acting as an attorney for one or more school districts in Washington, the Washington State School Directors' Association, or the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction. This means I have performed legal services for at least one school district within the last twelve months.

Name(s) of School District(s) you currently represent:

- Retired from the practice of law and formerly a member of the Council

The Washington Council of School Attorneys was formed to: (a) identify current legal problems of concern to those who advise school boards, to disseminate legal information to its members, and to promote the exchange of legal information and analysis among the members; (b) plan and prepare programs for the purpose of providing in-service trainings to its members or for informing school administrators and directors of current legal developments; and (c) identify and represent the general interests of attorneys who advise school boards, including the filing of amicus briefs or other activities which promote the effective legal representation of school districts.

Membership includes: 1) Registration and meals at two one-day, WSBA/MCLE-accredited workshops per year (Ethics credit is typically provided at the Spring workshop); submission of workshop participants' MCLE credits to WSBA, a copy of the Common School Manual, inclusion on the COSA roster (optional), which is posted to the WSSDA website, and participation in the COSA e-mail distribution list.
